Immediately after high school graduation, Kurt found his true career path, when he discovered the rewards of working with his hands. After learning the trade with major contracting firms, he established his own company, CSTM Corporation, whose initials identify his particular specialties: copper, slate, tile and metal. With the challenge of planning, rigging, and working many feet above the ground, Kurt's projects have included major Rochester landmarks, such as Christ Church, First Universalist Church, St. Stanislaus Catholic Church, the Frank Lloyd Wright-designed Boynton House, and numerous historic homes in our nine-county region. These buildings feature new or restored roofs, whose copper, slate, metal, and tile cladding will give them another century of protection. Known for his precise and exacting standards, Kurt performs a vitally important service that is appreciated by all his clients.
